# PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE

Most of you will be aware that the Parish Council during the second half of February, saw resignations from some of its members which left only 2 remaining members – Cllr. Ian Smith and Cllr. Matt Hubbard. This means that the March 2017 meeting was not able to be held as the Council needs at least 3 members present to be able to hold a meeting – known as a quorum.

Therefore, we have been in touch with NELC, and as the local electoral authority, NELC has the power under Section 91 of the Local Government Act, to appoint temporary members to the Parish Council to enable it to meet. These temporary members are usually from NELC's own elected member group and sit on the Parish Council only until it has a quorum once more. NELC will hold its own full Council meeting on Thursday 23rd March 2017 and this item is on its agenda to be approved and arrange temporary member(s) on the Parish Council's behalf.

The good news is that the Parish Council now has 7 residents who have come forward to stand for cooption to the Council. This would mean, if they are all successful, that the Parish Council would then be back up to 9 members, with only one vacancy remaining. When new members are coopted, which hopefully will be at the April meeting, those temporary members appointed by NELC will no longer be required.

The next scheduled meeting of the Parish Council is Tuesday 11th April at 7.00 pm and it is hoped that on that evening, the prospective new members will be coopted and the Council will continue with its normal meeting schedule every month. **Healing Parish Council Notes from March 2017. The Parish Council was not able to hold a March meeting as there were only 2 members remaining on the Council.**

NELC as the local electoral authority is able to appoint a temporary member to the Parish Council from its own elected members and so would be making such an appointment at its full Council meeting to be held on Thursday 23rd March. A sealed order would then be produced which would appoint temporary members to the Parish Council enabling it to meet on 11th April 2017, which is the next scheduled meeting date for the Parish Council.

At the April meeting, there will be 7 candidates who have put themselves forward for cooption and these candidates will be considered. Any cooptions made will then make the Parish Council quorate once more and the temporary members appointed will not then be required.

There will be a further update on both the Facebook page, the Website and in the next edition of this Newsletter.

## **Highways & Footpaths**

The Parish Council is still waiting for implantation of the scheme placing restrictions on parking on verge and footways and has been advised that

the reason NELC has not yet been able to implement the scheme is due to an error in the wording of the advertised 'order' which was placed in the local press.

## **Planning Applications**

There were no planning applications discussed in March as the Council did not hold a meeting.

Minutes of all the meetings, which show the Parish Council's comments on planning applications, are on the Parish Council's website.

## **Healing Village Hall**

Minor repair works have now been completed and there are no further works outstanding. The Healing Jellytots group have now reserved a second morning, and now also meeting on Friday mornings as well as Wednesday mornings and there are also new dog training classes on Thursday evenings at the Hall.

## **Future Dates and Reports**

The Parish Council Clerk during the last month has met with the Traffic

Team Manager from NELC to discuss parking and other traffic issues and also attended a Grounds Maintenance Service meeting with NELC to be advised on services from the local authority for the coming year. The Parish Council is also represented at various meetings with outside bodies, including the Town and Parish Liaison Meeting, which was held in March 2017.

### **Poplar Road Park**

The Parish Council, with effect from 1st April 2017, is now in charge of the management of the local parks at both Fords Avenue and Poplar Road Park. This local management includes the management and maintenance of the Bowling Green at Poplar Park and the repairs and maintenance of both of the play areas. It is hoped to increase and improve usage of the Pavilion at the Park and this facility will be discussed by the Council.

### **Finance**

The Parish Council authorised monthly payments and also updated its mandate for signatories on the accounts. Further updates will also take place when additional new members are coopted.

All members had been given copies of the budget for fy 17/18 and the budget was also publicised in the February edition of the Newsletter and is also available on the Parish Council website.

### **Next Meeting**

The next meeting will be on Tuesday 11th April 2017 at 7.00 pm at Healing Village Hall. As always, the press and public are most welcome to attend.

### **Crime**

Other crime was a report of harassment by known persons.

There has been no reports of ASB.

# MANAGEMENT OF POPLAR ROAD AND FORDS AVENUE PARKS BY THE PARISH COUNCIL

From 1st April 2017, the Parish Council will be taking on the management and maintenance of our two local parks – Poplar Road Park and Fords Avenue Park.

The Parish Council will be responsible for play equipment maintenance, grass and hedge cutting and also in the case of Poplar Road Park, looking after and maintaining the tennis courts, the bowling green, the Pavilion building and the car park.

The Bowling Club and the Parish Council are now working together to ensure that bowling continues for this coming season and a mower has now been purchased for use on the bowling green. The Bowling Club is making a financial contribution towards the upkeep of the Green for this coming season. It is hoped to open up the facilities to wider use and the Parish Council will be considering ways to do this during its first year of management of the parks. The tennis nets will hopefully also be upgraded ready for this spring/summer. The Parish Council is fully committed to keeping the parks to a high standard and hopefully, over time, improving the facilities.

## **Invitation for receipt of quotations:**

The Parish Council will be responsible for

the cutting of the grass on the main areas of both Poplar Park and Fords Avenue parks and also for the cutting of the grass on the bowling green.

## **Schedule 1:**

The main grassed areas for both parks will be cut once per week during the peak growing months of May to September and once a fortnight off peak for March/April and October. The remaining months would see a cut only if required. The grass is to be left on site.

## **Schedule 2:**

There are two main hedges on site – one being around the bowling green and the other adjacent to Hawthorne Avenue, Healing. They will require cutting twice per year and all debris/cuttings removed from the site.

## **Schedule 3:**

The bowling green is to be cut twice per week from April through to the end of September and occasionally with an extra cut during the bowling season if required. The Parish Council will have its own mowing equipment just for use on the bowling green.
