### **Crime**

There have been 24 reported crimes across the Wolds Ward for June, of which three have occurred in Healing, all relating to reports of assault.

During July to date (11<sup>th</sup> July) there has been one further report. During the evening of 6<sup>th</sup> July, a premises on Pegasus Way on EuroParc was entered by forcing a rear fire door. Vehicle keys were stolen.

There have been no reports of ASB.
