

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING FOR THE PARISH OF HEALING HELD ON TUESDAY 9th MAY 2017 AT THE CONFERENCE ROOM, HEALING VILLAGE HALL, HEALING AT 6.45 PM.

2. Chairman’s Report and presentation of the Annual Parish Council Report for 16/17

Chairman welcomed everyone and gave short overview of the year. Highlighted issues from Annual Report and asked the record to show thanks on behalf of the Council to all its staff members - the litter picker, two village hall staff and the Clerk.

3. Ward Cllrs’/NELC Report

Cllr. Dickerson gave Ward Report on issues within the Parish and also within NELC. Issues included stopping up of the layby, resurfacing works to The Avenue and Oak Road; verge parking restrictions scheme. Borough issues included provision of public toilets, company vehicles parking; development grant to Cleethorpes; Grimsby development along the waterfront area and more enforcement officers.

Cllr. Hasthorpe advised he was the other Ward Cllr for the area and highlighted the Town and Parish Liaison Committee which covers all PC matters for Parishes throughout the borough – he acts as Chairman of the meeting. Also encouraged all Councils to support ERNLLCA by attending district meetings.

Chairman thanked both Ward Cllrs. for their report.

4. Matters raised by members of the public

Residents raised verge parking restrictions and asked for timescales; major historic event of 70th anniversary of donation of British Legion field to the village and invitation for the Parish Council to join in with the Legion and local residents to celebrate the event.

There were no other matters raised.
