## August 2016

### 1914-1918 WORLD WAR 1 CENTENARY - REMEMBERED

This year has been a very significant year in remembrance to those who gave their lives during the Great War.

#### **31th May 1916 "The Battle of Jutland"**

The Battle of Jutland was fought from the 31st May to 1st June 1916. There was a loss of 4380 lives.

There were 6 battleships, 1 coastal battleship and 14 other ships sunk. 7 ships captured and 6 ships disarmed.

A service was held at Grimsby Minster for those who lost family members. I was very privileged to be invited to hear readings of those who were there and survived.

#### **1st July 1916 "The Battle of the Somme"**

In remembrance "**Whistle for the Somme**".

At 7.30am on 1st July 1916 whistles blew along The Western Front as a signal to the troops to go "over the top"; this was the start of one of the bloodiest battles of the Great War, the Battle of the Somme.

The Royal British Legion decided to hold a service at the Healing War Memorial. We gathered at 7.26am for the Last Post, Two Minute Silence and Reveille. At 7.30am we blew the

whistle to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice in the Battle of the Somme.

We laid a special wreath, it has blue cornflowers in which were also in the fields with the poppies.

When you heard the whistle, your thoughts went to what those brave soldiers must have been feeling on that day knowing the fate ahead of them.

Unfortunately the Branch decided on their plans at the last minute so there was no opportunity to advertise.

#### **Our Village War Memorial**

I was very disappointed to see the War Memorial looking so untidy on Armed Forces Day.

The Parish Council had placed an order for the War Memorial to be cleaned however the contractor had not managed to get it done.

I couldn't see it looking so untidy and uncared for our village hero's who's names are displayed that I organised for it to be swept. Two large rubbish sacks were cleared.

We need volunteers to do generally tidying of areas of the village, so that we can be proud of where we live.

There were no planning applications for the July meeting, but a separate planning meeting was called for the following week. Minutes of all the meetings, which show the Parish Council's comments on planning applications, are on the Parish Council's website.

## **Healing Village Hall**

The kitchen refurbishment has now been completed with regard to the new kitchen cabinets etc. and the last remaining part of the works is the installation of new flooring.

## **Future Dates and Reports**

Over the next month, the Parish Council would be represented at the Town and Parish Liaison Meeting and the ERNLLCA District Meeting, both to

be held at Grimsby town Hall during July.

## **Healing Cenotaph**

The Parish Council has booked in a clean for the Cenotaph which will be carried out shortly. The Parish Council has been approached by the Legion with regard to a possible ornamental railing at the Cenotaph on which wreaths could be placed and this matter is being discussed.

## **Poplar Road Park**

A formal final request has now been made of NELC for the Parish Council to take over the management of both Poplar Road and Fords Avenue parks by the Parish Council and this should now be progressed in liaison with NELC over the coming weeks

## **Finance**

The Parish Council has complied with all of the requirements of its audit process and submitted all of its documentation as well as exercising the public rights to inspect for the compliant period.

## **Next Meeting**

The next meeting will be on Tuesday 9th August 2016 at 7.00 pm at Healing Village Hall. As always, the press and public are most welcome to attend.



# HEALING WI – 8TH JUNE 2016

The meeting began with the singing of Jerusalem, after which President, Janet Littlewood, welcomed members and speaker Olympic gold medallist, Sharon Rendle MBE (1993) and her training partner, Diane Bell.

I was looking forward to this evening as I missed Sharon's talk to the Healing Society last November and I remembered meeting her once before when she visited local schools following winning gold at the 1992 games. She also coached pupils in judo for a while. She is the same, relaxed and friendly person I remembered and she talked for almost an hour without recourse to notes. We learned that she was a gymnast and swimmer who became involved in judo at the age of ten. After watching the 1976 Olympics she startled her parents by announcing that one day she would compete in the games and bring home a gold medal and in 1992 she fulfilled her own prediction. Sharon talked not only of her success in the World Championships and Commonwealth Games which led up to Olympic triumph but also of her work coaching children in a local club. She also spoke of how judo came to be recognised as a competitive sport in the world's sporting arenas. Everyone was fascinated to be able to view and handle Olympic Gold, Silver and Bronze medals.

We all enjoyed the talk and agreed with Anne Storey's vote of thanks in which she spoke of local pride in the bringing

of one of only seven Olympic gold medals in judo to Grimsby.

# WOLDS WARD HEALING UPDATE

## JULY 2016

### **Crime**

There have been 24 reported crimes across the Wolds Ward for June, seven of which have occurred in Healing.

During the early hours of 4th June, a silver Norco full suspension mtb was stolen from the roof rack of a car parked on its drive on Nicholson Road.

Sometime over 21st & 23rd June, somebody has used a stunning device in order to stun fish in a pond on Fords Avenue. 3 Koi Carp have been stolen, however, the actions have left about 50 gold fish and another 2 Koi dead.

A garden shed on Oak Road was broken into overnight 22nd & 23rd June. A quantity of power tools were stolen.

The remaining four reports refer to three offences of assault and a theft of mobile phone.

There were no reports of ASB during June.
