

Outcome of Public Consultation on Village Hall Project

The Parish Council met last night to collate the results of its consultation on the village hall project. There were 56 slips/emails returned, of which 49 were in favour of the Parish Council proceeding with the project and 7 were against. So of those that submitted their views, over 87% were in favour of the Parish Council proceeding further with the project.

The Council has noted some negative comments made by those who were 'against' the project and these comments have been taken on board and wherever possible the Council will seek to build in structures to mitigate the potential difficulties people have identified.

What next?

In the light of these results the Council will now proceed to commission a set of initial plans for a new facility at Poplar Park and will be discussing these plans in forthcoming meetings before seeking planning permission. Residents are, as always, most welcome to attend these meetings as our discussions progress. We will also confirm a valuation of the existing Village Hall and agree a process for its possible sale.
