POLICE REPORT

Wolds Ward Healing Update

Crime

There were thirty eight reported crimes across the Wolds Ward during January. Seven offences were reported in Healing.

Between 16th & 23rd January, an insecure garage at a property on Nicholson Road was entered. Tools were stolen.

Around teatime on 10th January, three youths approached a motorbike parked in a bike shed at the owner's place of work on EuroParc. The youths damaged the steering lock but were disturbed by staff and left the scene before anything else occurred.

Other crimes include:

Threats by a neighbour to cause damage to a resident's car for parking in front of his property.

One report of harassment.

Two assaults.

Sending inappropriate photos over social media.

There were two reports of ASB.

Two reports of motorbikes being ridden illegally on Station Road and on land at the rear of Healing Manor.



HEALING GREEN GROUP

It has been a quiet few months with the chilly weather and short days so it's not been possible to get too much done.

The main patch of stinging nettles at the Moated Settlement were cut back and then sprayed. It should now be possible to clear that area completely and develop it as a nice grassy picnic place over the next couple of years.

Around 80 bare-root tree and hedge plants from the Woodland Trust have been planted around the Moated Settlement. They are very small at the moment so will need to be looked after to prevent the weeds from winning. So fingers crossed. Some of these trees have been used to mark out a large circular section which is being cleared and can then be set-up as a wild flower garden which everyone can contribute to.

Two substantial bird nesting boxes which were donated to Brody Cartrer for his Healing eco project have been put up in trees adjacent to the Village Hall. Brody is also going to covert two boxes made by a local resident into bug hotels which we will locate at the other end of the village.

So, hopefully, all good for improving biodiversity in the local area. But there is still lots more that can be done so if you have any ideas or there is something you want to do, please contact

taken days using traditional methods. The data I collected was processed in Reality Capture, outputting a highly detailed render of the site's topography.

Photogrammetry models are limited by what the camera can see, and unfortunately the thick vegetation on site prevented this model from showing the intricacies of the former settlement. Despite this, the data that was produced is still incredibly useful. The terrain model we were able to produce could be invaluable when planning construction, investigating flood risk or assessing the volume of materials or tree cover.

LiDAR uses lasers to collect data, making it less limited than photogrammetry's image-based collection but substantially increasing the post processing. When we return to the Moated Settlement in the coming weeks, our drone will be able to penetrate the site's foliage, potentially uncovering archaeological remains from Healings past.

UAV Mapping Missions at Healing Moated Site

Survey Air is a professional UAV company that has conducted aerial building surveys nationwide for the last 5 years. As part of my role as UAV Specialist, I'm currently leading the expansion of our drone services into high-accuracy geospatial mapping. Using advanced drone technology, we capture real-world data from buildings and landscapes, processing it into 3D models and point clouds with sub-3cm accuracy. These models can then be refined and exported into various industry formats, providing valuable insights across industries.

In January, we were looking for sites where we could test our new methodologies, and as a Healing local, I immediately thought of the Medieval moated site as a great candidate. Capturing the site from an aerial perspective could reveal features of Healing's past that aren't visible to the naked eye. The location and surroundings of the field also gave us a great opportunity to verify our data's value for industries where precise pre-site assessments are essential. We planned two aerial surveys of the site, each using different technologies. The first, completed in January, used photogrammetry, while the second, scheduled for the near future, will use a LiDAR scanner.

The photogrammetry capture was a success. Within 2 hours I had gathered a comprehensive data set, something which would have
